

# UFUK ASSOCIATION FOR RELIEF AND DEVELOPMENT

**Sectors of Specialism and Objectives** 





UFUK Association for Relief and Development operates across multiple humanitarian and development sectors, combining emergency relief with sustainable recovery and community empowerment. The organization's experience is particularly strong in crisis-affected areas — most notably Palestine (Gaza Strip, West Bank, and Jerusalem) — where it implements large-scale, locally coordinated humanitarian interventions.

### 1. Emergency Relief and Humanitarian Response

Providing rapid, life-saving assistance to individuals and families affected by wars, displacement, and natural disasters.

- Emergency food and non-food item (NFI) distribution
- Hot meal programs and emergency kitchen operations
- Winterization projects (blankets, heaters, winter clothing)
- Urgent medical aid, hospital support, and cash assistance for families in crisis

# 2. Food Security and Nutrition

Enhancing food accessibility and combating malnutrition through sustainable local interventions.

- Distribution of food parcels, flour, and bread baskets
- Support to bakeries and community kitchens
- Nutrition-sensitive programs for children and pregnant women
- Agricultural rehabilitation and small-scale farming initiatives

## 3. Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH)

Ensuring safe and consistent access to clean water and hygiene services for affected populations.

- Water well drilling and rehabilitation
- Water trucking and daily distribution to households and shelters
- Maintenance of damaged water networks and sanitation facilities
- Distribution of hygiene kits and hygiene awareness campaigns



# 4. Health and Medical Support

Providing healthcare services and medical relief for vulnerable patients.

- Support for hospitals with medical equipment and consumables
- Organization of medical operation days (covering surgeries and specialized treatments for patients in need)
- Medical aid and referrals for chronic or emergency cases
- Mental health and psychosocial support (MHPSS) for affected families

# 5. Shelter, Housing, and Reconstruction

Restoring safety and dignity for displaced and affected families through shelter and home rehabilitation.

- Repairing damaged and uninhabitable houses for poor and displaced families
- Reconstruction of shelters and community facilities
- Transitional shelter assistance for families affected by conflict or disasters
- Provision of household materials and furniture for vulnerable families

### 6. Education and Child Welfare

Promoting education and supporting the protection and development of children.

- School rehabilitation, provision of supplies and uniforms
- Educational sponsorships for orphans and vulnerable children
- Non-formal education and remedial classes
- Recreational, psychological, and social support programs for children

### 7. Orphan Care and Sponsorship Programs

Providing long-term care and holistic support to orphaned children and their families.

- Monthly sponsorship programs covering basic living needs
- Educational, psychological, and health support for orphans
- Family strengthening and community-based care initiatives
- Regular follow-up and reporting to ensure transparency and impact









# 8. Livelihoods and Economic Empowerment

Supporting self-reliance through income-generating and vocational programs.

- Small business grants and micro-projects for families in need
- Vocational training and skills development
- Women's empowerment through home-based production and entrepreneurship
- Agricultural and livestock livelihood support

### 9. Social Care and Protection

Safeguarding the rights and dignity of vulnerable individuals and communities.

- Assistance to widows, persons with disabilities, and the elderly
- Awareness sessions on protection, inclusion, and gender equality
- Safeguarding mechanisms to prevent exploitation, abuse, and neglect

## 10. Sustainable Development and Community Resilience

Building community resilience and long-term recovery through sustainable practices.

- Capacity-building for local partners and community-based organizations
- Environmental protection, tree planting, and green initiatives
- Promotion of renewable energy and sustainable agriculture
- Advocacy for humanitarian principles and social justice

# 11. Geographical Expertise – Palestine and Crisis Contexts

UFUK Association possesses extensive operational experience and partnerships in **Palestine (Gaza Strip, West Bank, and Jerusalem)**, implementing projects in highly complex humanitarian environments.

- Proven capacity for rapid emergency response in active conflict zones
- Strong partnerships with local civil society and municipal bodies
- Coordination with international donors and UN-led humanitarian clusters
- Deep contextual understanding of community needs and access mechanisms
